## **CCMS-AAEM Breveloquent Competition**

## Requirements for Eligibility to Submit

- 1. Medical students, residents, fellows, and young physicians (within 5 years post-residency or fellowship) are eligible to submit.
- 2. Medical students, residents, and first year fellows must have a critical care trained mentor to aid with their presentation development. CCMS mentors are available.
- 3. AAEM or AAEM/RSA membership is required to submit. If invited to present at Scientific Assembly, the presenters must register themselves for the conference. Conference registration is free for AAEM and AAEM/RSA members.

The theme of this year's competition is "A Great Save with a Unique Intervention." The competition format is a 7-minute presentation provided on less than 25 slides. Clinical experience cases related to an ICU setting with a unique or less often used intervention are preferred. Submissions will be ranked and reviewed based on complexity of the case and your intervention. A travel stipend of \$500 will be provided to each invited speaker.

Education style slides are discouraged; the focus of the presentation should be on the case itself and your intervention – e.g. tell a story.

When submitting your abstract, you will be asked to provide:

- My great save was: (max 100 words)
  - Example: A hypercarbic respiratory failure that was salvaged with BiPAP
- Final diagnosis
- Description: (what is this presentation about)? (max 250 words)
